What is geocaching?

It's like a treasure hunt! Geocaching is an outdoor recreational activity, in which participants use a Global Positioning System receiver or mobile device and other navigational techniques to hide and seek containers, called geocaches or caches, at specific locations.

There can be one to several treasures in the container. And a log book that you date and sign. Then close everything up and place it back in its spot for the next cache hunter to find it!

It is like a treasure hunt, however, the treasure must stay in the cache (container) UNLESS you replace it with a new item of equal or greater value.
